The Salt Mines explores the lives of Sara, Gigi and Giovanna, three Latino transvestites who for years have lived on the streets of Manhattan supporting their drug addictions through prostitution. They made their temporary home inside broken garbage trucks that the Sanitation Department keeps next to the salt deposits used in the winter to melt the snow. The three friends share the place known as "The Salt Mines" with a varied community of homeless people. In the documentary they talk about their sexual identity, their past and their dreams. We follow their daily lives, day and night, until the place is closed and sealed by the city, forcing everyone to disperse.

Mango **Dawn Passar**

5 minutes 16 mm US 1992 Passar's meditative remembrance of a mango tree becomes a shared secret of childhood games, sibling rivalries and ghost stories. As she peels away each layer of the Mango, memories of her Thai hometown, Lopburi, grow increasingly lucid.

The ordeal of Taipei's licensed prostitutes began, when on September 6, 1997, licensed prostitution was overnight abolished and the licenses of 128 prostitutes, who had worked legally before, were revoked. This video documents the struggle of the prostitutes to demand their right to work and to assert their leadership role on policies concerning sex work. The brothels of Taipei's licensed prostitutes reopened about a week ago, March 28, 1999. "Their struggle and their success have shown that even society's weaker members have a voice and can obtain their rights." -- Collective of Sex Workers and Supporters



A group of female vigilantes work out of a seedy New York go-go bar as a front for their undercover activities. The five women, who are survivors of abuse, poverty and imprisonment, share a collective mission: to blow away the worst rapists and predators of women. Jesse, the leader, is borderline psychotic and directs operations with a murderous zeal. Punishment meted out on offending men is swift and bloody. Castration and death is the agenda. The women inhabit a nocturnal city that is shot through with psychological and physical violence. Into this maelstrom comes Allison, a suburban Ohio housewife who is seeking anonymity after killing her abusive husband. No sooner does she arrive than she is ambushed by two hoodlums who are in the process of raping her when the vigilante girls show up. A Gun For Jennifer, made on the slimmest of budgets, is an extraordinary tour-de-force. Exhilarating and disturbing by turns, it offers no easy answers but provides a powerful image of a civilization moving into a new Dark Age.

In the history of adult cinema no name is better known than that of John C Holmes. As filmmaker Paul Anderson (director of Boogie Nights) states: "I think you could mention the porn stars from today's world and housewives in the middle of America wouldn't know what the hell you were talking about, but if you mention John Holmes, everyone knows "

Wadd is a documentary that explores the many facets of the life and world of this pop culture icon From his childhood in rural Ohio to his death from AIDS, this film unravels the myths surrounding Holmes and lays bare the darker side of his persona.

The film is told through the recollections of those people Holmes left permanent marks on. His first wife of 19 years, who married him when he was still underage, and that no one in the porn world knew existed. His 15 year-old mistress, who he pimped for drugs and money. The police detectives who investigated the murder in which Holmes was the primary suspect. A multitude of fellow adult actors and actresses as well as historians, friends and filmmakers.

"This is really an American story, this story, what happened to John," LA Times film critic Ken Curan observes The reinvention of self, rags to riches and ultimate self-destruction that is so cliche is typified in Wadd; but when sex, drugs, a sociopathic mind and a 13-inch penis are thrown in, the story is far from cliche.






